

How to ask your patients if they wish to sign up to KeepSight

Below are some suggested options you can use to explain KeepSight and seek consent from a patient with diabetes to sign them up.

- As part of your diabetes eye screening today, I will send your GP a report and can sign you up with KeepSight. KeepSight will remind you when you are due for your next diabetes eye check. Is that okay?
- As with all health screenings associated with diabetes, I will send a report of today's visit to your GP. I can also sign you up with KeepSight, which will ensure you receive regular reminders about your next diabetes eye check. Is that okay?
- As part of the diabetes eye check, I will be sending a report to your GP and I can also sign you up with KeepSight. KeepSight will send you a reminder when you are due for your next diabetes eye check. Is that okay with you?
- A diabetes eye check is an important regular check-up if you have diabetes. I'll be sending a report to your GP and can sign you up with KeepSight. KeepSight is a reminder service whereby you'll get an email, letter or SMS reminding you when your next diabetes eye check is due. Is that okay?
