



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS – PRIZE DRAW

### METHOD OF ENTRY

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promoter is Optometry Australia Pty Ltd [ABN 17 004 622 431].
3. Entry is open to all registered Australian optometrists. Winner/s must be able to provide proof of their AHPRA registration number before prizes will be awarded. Employees of Optometry Australia (National and State Offices) and their immediate families are ineligible. By entering this competition, entrants will be deemed to agree with these terms of entry.
4. The competition commences on Wednesday, January 27 2021 at 09:00 AEDT and ends on Wednesday, February 17 2021 at 23:59 AEDT (the Promotion Period).
5. Entrants must be invited through a direct email, complete an online survey and upload their entry by the competition end time and date to be eligible to be entered into the draw. The entry requires the entrant to opt in and complete the following: "In 25 words or less, please tell us what has changed in your infection control practices since COVID-19?"
6. Entrants must include their full name, email address, and contact phone number. The researchers will de-couple prize draw entry responses from survey responses.
7. Only one entry per completed survey may be submitted.

### PRIZE

8. There will be four (4) winners from one (1) prize draw. Each winner will receive one (1) of the following:

9. All valid entries are automatically entered into the prize draw. Valid entries will be anonymised and provided to an Optometry Australia staff member for judging. The winner/s will be selected by Optometry Australia at 10:00 AEDT on Wednesday, March 10 2021, runners up will also be selected at this time. The winners of the prize draw will be notified by phone and/or email.
10. Should any of the prizes remain unclaimed after one month of the draw and every effort made to contact them with the information provided by the entrant, then Optometry Australia will award the prize to the runner/s up.

12. The prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash or other incentives.
