- 57 eligible survey respondents
 - 44 practice in Victoria
 - 13 in SA
- Most respondents practice in corporate (n=24) or independent (n=23)

- Improving the Diversity of Opportunities
 - Eye care in Non-Traditional Locations
 - Increasing Scope of Practice
 - Developing Multidisciplinary Ophthalmology Outpatient Care Models
 - Specialisation Endorsement



Member priorities

- Scope of Practice Expansion
 - 60% ranked Oral Medication endorsement as highest priority
 - Followed by YAG/PI and Intra-vitreal injections
